

## GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. Ponies must be registered with the S.P.S.B.S
2. Ponies shown in -hand may be entered in either the black, coloured or the small stock sections but not in more than one section.
3. Ponies may be measured at the discretion of the Judges & Stewards
4. Ponies must be shown in their natural state.
5. Foals must be a minimum of 3 weeks old on show day.
6. Mares with foals at foot may not be ridden or driven.
7. Ponies of 3 years with foals at foot may not be show.
8. Brown ponies are to be considered as black & shown as black
9. Colts 2 years old and over must be suitably bitted.
10. There must be no colts or entire males in the young handlers classes(excluding foals)
11. Children under 14 may not show colts (excluding foals) or entire males in in- hand classes.
12. Children under 11 may not show entire males in ridden classes.
13. In the interest of safety hard hats conforming to the current BS standard must be worn by all handlers aged 14 years and under.
14. Hard hats conforming with the current BS standard must be worn at all times by persons when mounted whether competitors or not.
15. No spurs to be worn.
16. Whips or canes to be a maximum of 30"
17. Ponies in ridden/driven classes must be 4 years old or over.
18. In ridden classes if a rider falls off at any time whilst in the ring both the pony and rider must leave the ring, rider dismounted, and take no further part in the class.
19. Driven classes will be judged in accordance with BDS rules.
20. Exhibitors must be appropriately dressed and there must be no individual stud, person or pony names displayed in any way in the ring.
21. Exhibitors should be aware that a judge may not place in a class a pony, which to his/hers knowledge has bred, sold, leased or produced by the judge or his immediate family or employer; nor may he/she place a pony in which he/she has a financial interest ;nor may he/she place a stallion by whom he/she has had a mare stunted in that season. Should a situation arise when such a pony appears, a referee, preferably on the appropriate panel of judges, should be appointed by the Show Secretary to place the pony in question in its position in the class.
22. Any pony found to be suffering from any contagious or infectious disease must be removed from the showground at the request of a veterinary Surgeon.
23. Please try to make sure that classes do not clash as no late arrivals will be admitted in the rings after judging has commenced.
24. The decision of the judges , show committee & stewards is final.
25. The show committee reserves the right to amend, amalgamate or cancel any classes or to replace a judge if necessary.
26. Any objection must be lodged in writing with a sum of £20(twenty pounds)

within 30 minutes of the alleged incident. The deposit will be returned if the objection is upheld.

27. No entry fee will be refunded.
28. Dogs must be on a lead at all times.
29. Neither the Society nor the Show Organisers shall be liable for anything that may happen from any cause or circumstances whatsoever, to any person, animal article or property. It is the condition of entry that each exhibitor/competitor shall indemnify the show against such matters aforesaid when signing the entry form.
30. In all respects not covered in these General Conditions, the committee adopts the rules of the SPSBS.
31. Age of the pony to be declared on the entry form.
32. Age of the Rider/Young Handler to be declared on the entry for.
33. Exhibitors signatures on the entry form signifies acceptance of the above conditions.
34. No Naked flames anywhere on the show field. This includes Barbeques.
35. No Penning of ponies on the showground.
36. There are no electric hook-ups on the site.
37. **The show field is a short distance from the stables however it is recommended that people move up to the show field for the show and show from boxes.**
38. Site gates shut at 10.00p.m. on the Saturday evening and will reopen at 6.00 a.m. on the Sunday morning. If you are going to arrive outside these times please contact our emergency number which is 07960011315 (David Gibson).
39. A deposit is required with every stable however I will be returned on inspection of vacated stables.
40. Stables will be on first come first serve stables
41. Bedding must be ordered on the entry form.
42. Communication is preferably by email with the exception of entry forms which must be mailed.
43. Boxes cannot be mucked out on to the showground.
44. After the AGM there is a buffet to which tickets are £7.50 and these should be purchased with entries.
45. All entrants should have third party liability insurance cover.
